



How to get your students started on Mathseeds

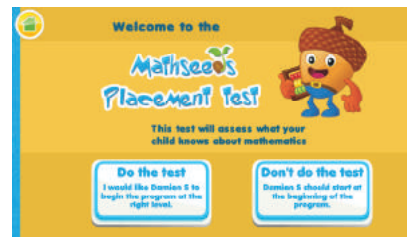
Our Quickstart Guide will help you successfully launch Mathseeds with your students in a few easy steps. The assumption is that each student has access to a computer, or at least one computer between two students. Students should wear headsets for audio support.

Students should start by going to www.mathseeds.com and click the Login button.

Step 1: Placement Test

Once logged in the student should click on **Buddy**, the acorn character in the center of the screen.

The Mathseeds Placement Test will launch to test your students' knowledge and place them on the appropriate Mathseeds lesson.



Step 2: Lessons

Students are now able to work at their own pace to complete Mathseeds lessons and journey their way through the maps.

Students are rewarded with acorns when a lesson is completed. A pet/critter is hatched at the end of each map.

Students will need to pass a quiz at the end of each map to move forward.

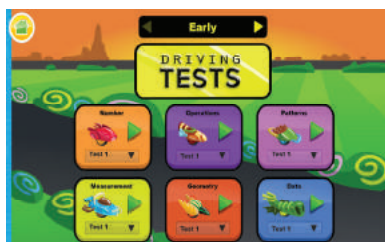
Quiz certificates can be printed from the Teacher Dashboard.



Step 3: Driving Tests

Each Driving Test has 10 questions that check for students' knowledge of core concepts.

All students will start with Test 1 for each concept. Driving Tests are optional for students and their attempts and successes are reported in the Teacher Dashboard.



Step 4: Engagement and Awards

Students can access the Play, Shop, Arcade and Treehouse sections for further activities, to personalize their Mathseeds experience, view certificates and spend awarded acorns.

No results are reported to teachers when students access these four areas.





Quickstart Guide for Teachers

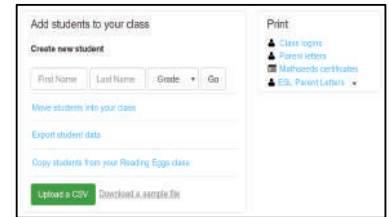
Our Quickstart Guide for teachers will help you set up your students on Mathseeds as well as report on their progress in a few easy steps.

Log into your Teacher Dashboard at www.mathseeds.com and click on the 'Math' tab in the upper left corner.

Step 1: Generate Student Usernames and Passwords (U/P)

Select 'Manage Class'

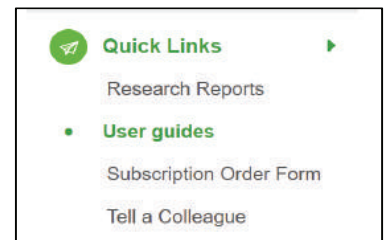
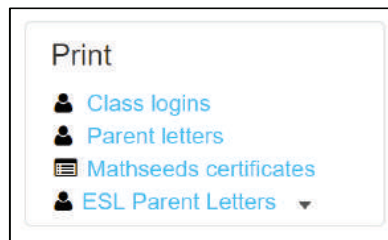
Enter student names and grade levels individually or upload an Excel (CSV) file of your class roster to create their username and passwords.



If you have a current Reading Eggs class, save time by clicking 'Copy students from your Reading Eggs class' to generate Mathseeds access with the same U/P as Reading Eggs.

Step 2: Print Important Documents

Print class login details with students' U/P to distribute and parent letters in various languages to send home with your students.



Print technical requirements for your IT Coordinator.

Select **Quick Links** from the main menu and then **User Guides** to print technical requirements and troubleshooting guides.

Step 3: Student Login

Students can log in at www.mathseeds.com using their U/P from their login cards.



Real learning, real math, really fun!



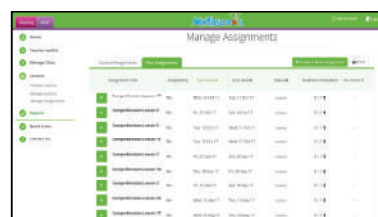
Alternatively for younger learners, sign in with your Teacher U/P on each computer, click 'Start Mathseeds' where students select their name to access their Student Dashboard.

Ensure to schedule time to access computers and/or tablets to launch Mathseeds with your students.

Step 4: Lessons and Reporting

Click on 'Lessons' from the main menu and select 'Preview Lessons' to preview Mathseeds lessons and access resources such as student and teacher lesson plans and worksheets.

Select 'Manage Assignments' to create assignments for students.



Select 'Teacher Toolkit' from the main menu to find Curriculum Maps.

Select 'Reports' from the main menu to view student work and print student certificates.
